GENERAL INFORMATION

St. Andrew's scholarships provide financial assistance to help meet the expenses of obtaining a post-secondary education.

Applicants are evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Attendance and participation in activities at St. Andrew's
- Family members' attendance and participation in activities at St. Andrew's
- Responses to all 7 essay questions
- Acceptance at, or enrollment in, an accredited education Institution. (Exceptions will be considered on a case-by-case basis)
- Registration in a continuing education opportunity/workshop/conference appropriate to applicant's work or study
- First time applicants are those who have never applied for a scholarship from St. Andrews before, or those who may have applied before but did not receive scholarship dollars in the previous award year.
- Renewal applicants are those who received scholarship dollars in the previous award year.
